

Access Request for UCM Lactation Rooms

In an effort to maintain private, clean, and safe lactation rooms in high-traffic areas, access to the following lactation rooms on campus must be requested:

- Kolligian Library 1st floor lactation room adjacent to the women's restroom (has refrigerator and has no sink but next to restroom)
- Social Sciences and Management Building (SSM): 2nd floor 214 (has refrigerator)
- Student Services Building (SSB): 2nd Floor next to restrooms-Room #2T3 (has refrigerator)
- Classroom and Office Building 2 (COB2): 3rd floor 3T3 Across from 312
- Science and Engineering Building 2: 3rd floor, SOE2-312 (has refrigerator)
- Student Activities and Athletics Center (SAC): 1st floor Women's bathroom
- DCC; room# 109 & 309
- Arts and Computational Sciences (ACS) 224 (has no sink but close to bathroom)

Provide the following to be granted access:

- Full name
 - Employee or Student ID number
 - E-mail and phone number
 - Your affiliation
 - Estimated amount of time you will need access to the facilities
- Requests for access can take up to 72 business hours to be granted. Your access may be granted up to a period of 2 years or less and may be extended by submitting a new request. Temporary access can be accessed by contacting Yesenia Curiel.
 - By being authorized access, you agree to the following terms:
 - to furnish your own containers and accessories needed to pump;
 - to clean up any spills or other untidiness created during use of the room;
 - for securing the room after each use;
 - to use the room for lactation purposes only;
 - not to allow others to enter the room if they are not authorized to do so.
